



ASRTU Forum in the Crimea (“Alushta-2017”)

Introduction:

Founding of the Association of Sino-Russian Technical Universities (ASRTU) has become a very important milestone in the development of Russian and Chinese educational cooperation. During the whole period of its activity ASRTU has organized a wide range of very important educational, scientific, social and political events.

ASRTU forum in the Crimea “Alushta-2017” will hold up traditions of friendship and cooperation between Chinese and Russian universities. Within the framework of this forum various scientific and educational events are to be held, as well as events aimed at establishing links between Russian and Chinese undergraduate and postgraduate students.

The forum will be held on 7-13 May 2017 in the Recreational Educational Center “Alushta” of Moscow Aviation Institute (National Research University). The center is located in the Republic of Crimea. MAI is currently presiding as one of ASRTU co-chairmen.

Forum goals:

Within the framework of this forum the following events are to be held:

- workshops organized and conducted by MAI teaching staff and industry representatives;
- students’ aerospace projects contest. Within the framework of this contest the business role-play game on aircraft design and 3D printing school is to be conducted;
- working group meeting on the development of ASRTU small satellite.

The workshops will be conducted by MAI leading professors and will be aimed at obtaining new competencies in the field of the cutting-edge aircraft design technologies and new materials used in the aerospace industry.

As part of the role-play game the undergraduate and postgraduate students will be able to create aircraft models with the help of 3D printing. During the game the contest is to be conducted, the winners will receive prizes.

The cultural program includes:

- getting to know the culture and history of the Crimea as an integral part of Russian history and culture;
- visiting the federal city of Sevastopol on 9 May 2017 to watch the Warships Parade;
- students’ contests and competitions.

The working language of the forum is English.

Deadlines:

In order to obtain visa invitations the details of the forum participants must be sent by 17 March 2017.

In order to arrange meeting and transfer from the airport the time of the participants’ arrival must be sent by 20 April 2017.

Forum schedule:

- 7 May – participants’ arrival.
- 8 May – participants’ presentation, introductory workshops:
“MAI - Path to the Future”
“The use of product lifecycle management technology in modern aircraft design”.
- 9 May - trip to Sevastopol, visiting the Warships Parade.
- 10 May - workshops, educational programs and courses presentations:
Design of aircraft airframe components and elements from polymeric composite materials.
Presentations of innovative laboratories for aircraft design and manufacture.
Working group meeting on the development of ASRTU small satellite.
- 11 May - the students’ projects contest, seminars and presentations.
- 12 May - summarizing the forum results.
- 13 May – participants’ departure.

Financial terms for Chinese participants:

Participants from China are to pay airfare from China to Simferopol and back. MAI will provide transfer from the airport of Simferopol and back, accommodation and meals in the Recreational Educational Center "Alushta", the trip to Sevastopol.
